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



NEW ECONOMIC MODEL

- China reaches US consumption 2031 (8% growth)
- Oil 80 m barrels/day world production →80 m barrels/day(based car transportation)
- Grain 382 m tons→1.352 m tons= 2/3 world harvest
- Meat 64 m tons→181 m tons=4/5 world production
- Coal 2.8 b tons=2.5 b tons world production
- Steel 258 m tons→511 m tons>Industrialized West
- Paper 27 kgs/person→210 kgs/person=303m tons (double world production)
- Cars .77 cars person = 1.1 billion> 795 million cars on road
- Add India, and 3 billion in emerging markets and the West....




FIGURE 1: SNAPSHOT OF GLOBAL SUSTAINABLE INVESTING ASSETS, 2016–2018
