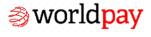






















Specimens removed to Endangered Species Display Drawer


